Subject: Awareness to Beat Plastic Pollution - regarding

This is notified to all Teaching/Non-Teaching Staff and student community that this year the Government of India is hosting the World Environment Day, 2018 at Global level in New Delhi in collaboration with UN. The theme for this year is "Beat Plastic Pollution". The Government has suggested to start actions in two ways: Awareness on Environmental Conservation and theme based awareness to "Beat Plastic Pollution". The following initiatives are suggested to be taken in the College:

- (i) All to refuse, reduce and reuse plastic products in their daily use. Pledge for plastic free environment in the College and in its surroundings.
- (ii) Ban single-use plastic water bottles, take-away coffee cups, lunch wrapped in disposable plastic packagings, plastic bags, disposable food service cups, plates and containers made of polystyrene foam, plastic straws etc., in the College premises and canteen.
- (iii) Encourage biodegradable and other types of compostable utensils in place of plastic and bring a fork, knife and spoon from home.
- (iv) Encourage use of durable, foldable and inexpensive reusable bag that can be carried around in car, pocket or purse.
- (v) Discourage plastic bottles. Have glass, steel or clay bottles in offices.
- (vi) Welcome innovative ideas to reduce plastic foot.
- (vii) Mobilize students of schools/colleges/University across the country in cleanliness drive.

All are requested to take action as suggested above and refuse, reduce, reuse and recycle plastics to combat the menace of plastics.
