Let me now briefly introduce our College.

Our College is a constituent College of University of Delhi. As a co-educational institute, it was established by the Government of NCT of Delhi in 1991 to cater to the needs of higher education in a school building of Geeta Colony. In 2001, the College shifted to the present building, the foundation stone of which was laid by the then Hon'ble Vice-President of India (Hon'ble Sh. K. R. Narayanan Ji). It is spread over 9 acres including a residential area having 12 staff quarters.

With a total student strength of about 3400 (girl students in good numbers), it has got about 136 faculty members including Adhocs and Guests, and the supporting staff comprising 79 members in addition to the few outsourced staff. The College offers a number of professional and honours courses like Business Economics, Hindi Journalism and Mass Communication, Applied Psychology, Social Work, Commerce, Economics, Hindi, Geography and History in addition to B.A. (Programme), B.Com and Urdu as an elective subject. Three other courses are in the pipeline. The College is privileged to have WUS Health Centre in its premises to look after the healthcare needs of College students and the staff of University of Delhi. The College is making all out efforts to complete its Print Media, Radio Recording and Work Station Labs. Thanks to Dr. Shashi and her Team.

Our College also supplements the efforts of the University and serves community by meeting the needs of higher education of the young population. It is one of the Regional-cum-Study Centres to facilitate undergraduate teaching for School of Open Learning (SOL), and for girl students of Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB, University of Delhi). Our College also acts as one of the Centres of Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Tamil Nadu, that offers a one year Post Graduate Diploma in Youth Development (PGDYD). Thanks to Dr. Arvind Kumar, Dr. D.K. Pandeya and Dr. Ravindra Singh who have been coordinating these programmes.

The College continues to be one of the 20 Earthquake Strong Ground Motion Stations in Delhi for recording and monitoring earthquakes in Delhi under the project jointly handled by Director of Seismology Division (DST)-DU-IIT (Roorkee).

The College constantly strives to improve its Good Practices, for which 'Special Commendation Prize' was awarded by University of Delhi in 2015. The College has registered well in time and much ahead of others with GeM for general purchases and PFMS for government grants. It celebrated its Silver Jubilee in 2015-16, and it is now NAAC accredited with B+ grade.

Let us quickly review the College activities.

Our College was made a 'Food Distribution and Hunger Centre' during the nationwide lock-down (April 2020) wherein a few hundred persons were offered food twice a day. The College family sincerely thanks our Account Officer Sh. Joginder Singh and his Team including Sh. Rajiv Saxena and Sh. Gulshan who helped the College by courageously confronting the

COVID-19 pandemic. Earnest thanks are also due to our ICT Section led by SNA (PKV) and his Team particularly Sh. Ratandeep, Sh. Sunil and Sh. Dushyant who were heavily loaded with work and promoted the online teaching-learning process and facilitating the organization of student-centered webinars with smiling faces. Our College is on the name of Bharat Ratna Baba Saheb, Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar. He was a multi-faceted personality - a great legal luminary known as the Father of the Indian Constitution, a social scientist par excellence, a prolific writer and an editor, a great social reformer and a brilliant orator. In order to acknowledge and create awareness among students and society about his life and mission, academic work and his contribution towards improving the lot of socially disadvantaged sections of population and building a new India based on the principles of justice, liberty, equality and fraternity, the College started Baba Saheb Bhim Rao Ambedkar Memorial Lecture Series in 2007 (the year, I joined) on the occasion of his birth anniversary. Since then, it has been continuing.

The inaugural Baba Saheb Memorial lecture was delivered by Prof. Namvar Singh on 14th April 2007. During the last year, the Lecture was delivered (online) on 14th April 2020 by Prof. Sanjay Paswan (Former Minister of State for Human Resource Development, GOI). Sir, you will be happy to know that our NCC Unit not only helps in nation building, but also makes a positive contribution by facilitating the College administration particularly during admission period as and when required particularly in the maintenance of discipline which is the most difficult task.

Further, ever since (2015) our College was nominated by GNCTD and the NCC Unit 2 Delhi Girls Battalion as the Nodal Agency to organize a Mega Event to popularize Yoga on the occasion of International Yoga Day (21st June), we have been continuing with Yoga Training of students. The College Yoga Committee organised a regular Yoga practice online from 16th – 20th June 2020 from 6:30 AM to 7:30 AM. Thanks to Dr. Bharat Bhusan. The International Day of Yoga was organised online on the theme *Ghar Ghar me Yog* (21st June 2021). Thanks to Resource person Vinod Kumar and the College Team led by Dr. D. K. Pandeya, Dr. Rajbala Gauttam and ex Sr. Cadet Vijender Singh Baghel.

Given that our College is located in a relatively low economic profile area of Delhi, the requirements of our heterogeneous group of students are different from those of other colleges. Students are encouraged to avail government sponsored Development Schemes and scholarships particularly meant for students belonging to the weaker sections including SC/ST/OBC/PwD/Minorities and others. The College and its Welfare/Fee Committee recommends some students for financial assistance.

The College recognizes that nature care and environmental education are crucial for sustainable human development and require an inclusive approach. The Eco-Club, constituted in 2009, has brought about a noticeable change with its student Team of Green Cadets. These Cadets combine the discipline of NCC, commitment of community development and love for 'Nature'.

Our Herbal Park with more than 110 medicinal plant varieties and Rose Garden with more than 86 plant varieties maintained under the guidance of Eco-Club continue to win top positions in Delhi University Flower Shows every year ever since we started participating in 2010. The college prize score jumped from 2 in 2010 (the year of first time entry) to 14 in 2018. The college has an inventory of about 524 trees (48 varieties), with about 159 plants including *Saptapri/Alstonia scholaris* which are widely known for their anti-pollution qualities.

Students are further encouraged to be eco-friendly and contribute to the college efforts to keep its campus clean and green through its 'Earn while Learn Scheme', the Eco-Club, the 'Paper Recycling Unit' and Gardening Committees further facilitated by our sectional heads including Mr. Joginder Singh and Sh. Ram Kumar.

The College functioning, as we all know, is the coordinated and cooperative effort of all the Administrative Wings, Committees, Departments, faculty and even students. The general infrastructure also facilitates the teaching-learning process. Efforts are being made to further improve the existing facilities related to Library, Canteen, Computer Labs (4), Sports Ground and the Air Conditioned Auditorium with a total seating capacity of about 250 persons. It is a matter of satisfaction that the construction of the second floor has been completed. Thanks to the PWD officials.

Our Library with floor wise signages is well equipped (books, approx. 41,399) with extended facilities like OPAC (through which Registered users can check their library accounts) and N-LIST (E-Journals) of INFLIBNET. This year the college has added 498 new books and subscribed to around 54 periodicals (17 English and 14 Hindi) in addition to 23 newspapers on the recommendations of TICs/Library Committee. The meritorious and economically weaker students are provided books under SAF scheme. Special facilities like separate AC Cabin with computer facility and online membership of *Sugamya Pustakalaya* are arranged by the library for our *Divyang* students. Special collections of Dr. Ambedkar, Gandhi, Nehru and other eminent personalities are also available in the library.

The College thanks all the Committee Convenors and their members who look after Central Purchases (Dr. Purshottam), Stock Verification (Dr. Rajesh Upadhyay), College Development and Welfare (Dr. Lalit Kumar), Admissions and Examinations (Dr. Nalin Kumar, Dr. Narender Thankur, Dr. M. S. Vats), Internal Assessment (Dr. M.S. Vats), Computer Lab Development (Mr. Purshottam and Dr. B. M. Dash), Master Time-Table (Dr. Sarla Bhardwaj), and so on.

The promotion of extra-curricular and co-curricular activities for students is equally important during studies. The respective College Departments, Societies and Committees organize such activities and programmes.

It is heartening to note that in spite of COVID-19 crisis, the Placement Cell organised placement drives and around 35 students found placements in 6 companies. Many companies are going to come during the next two months. Students placed with the highest package were offered Rs.5 lakh per annum.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

The IQAC has been stepping ahead to assure academic and administrative reforms in order to improve the overall performance of the College. More specifically, the initiatives of the IQAC are as follows:

Activities Undertaken by Previous Team (Dr. Atul Pratap Singh, Coordinator)

- Hosted an e-workshop for the students of our college on ‘Stress Management’ (by Ms. Tanu Girotra, former Medical Social Worker-cum-Nodal Officer at Chacha Nehru Bal Chikitsalaya, Delhi; Trainer; Life Coach; & Author) under IQAC (June 27, 2020).
- Hosted an e-workshop for the faculty of our college on ‘A Classroom after COVID-19’ (by Prof. Sanjai Bhatt, Professor & former Head, Department of Social Work, University of Delhi; & President, National Association of Professional Social Workers in India - NAPSWI) under IQAC (May 05, 2020).
- In view of the University of Delhi letter dated 27.03.2020 and e-mail dated 09.04.2020, the College has constituted a Task Force to deal with the situation arising due to Covid-19. The IQAC after threadbare discussion assisted in drafting a “Covid Advisory” in accordance with the advisory issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of HRD, UGC and University of Delhi, so that the academic activities could be maintained and the administrative responsibilities could be taken care of as desired in view of the constantly emerging circumstances (April, 2020).
- As per the Delhi University Press Release dated 12th March & 16th March 2020 and College Notice dated 13.03.2020 and regarding prevention of the pandemic condition arising due to COVID-19, regular classes were not held after mid-semester break and the teachers had the only option to work from their homes. Therefore, the IQAC initiated a participatory programme titled

“Students’ Friendly e-Library” under which the faculty members will have to share reading materials in different forms including e-books, reports, research papers, articles, popular web links & websites, blogs, news, films, documentaries, videos, audio tapes, PPTs, posters, clippings, news items, other relevant information, etc. All such reading materials will be classified and systematically arranged by the e-Library Team of the College (March, 2020).

Activities Undertaken by New Team (Dr. Bishnu Mohan Dash, Coordinator)

- The IQAC Team undertook the scrutiny of applications of Promotion of teachers from Stage 1 to Stage II, Stage II to Stage III and Stage III, Assistant Professor to Associate Professor.

The College is fully equipped with IT facilities including four computer labs, Internet access and multimedia projectors with interactive smart board. The college has high-speed Internet connectivity with 125 Mbps fiber optics provided by the University of Delhi and Airtel 4G Home WiFi connections for an official emergency etc.

Computer Labs are equipped with 10 (Ten) 5KVA and 2 (Two) 10KVA online UPS facilities with 1hrs power backup. The entire college campus is Wi-Fi enabled with UTM Box security system. The entire college campus is covered by 62 CCTV camera networks and the Library has 26 network cameras for security of students, staff and the college with separate surveillance room.

The college has established an IT Hub including 110 computers and 02 servers with the latest configuration. The Computer labs I, II, III, and IV are equipped with Smart Board for teaching and learning of students. The college received 813 laptops for students and 20 laptops for teachers from the University of Delhi, which were subsequently distributed to the students and faculty members for their academic practical etc. To improve IT infrastructure and teaching methodology, the College has installed 22 multimedia projectors provided by Delhi University in the classrooms with an equal number of laptops to teach students through it. The college is currently in the process of making its students attendance system online.

Heart Care Foundation, Holy Care Nursing College and Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar College, University of Delhi organised a live Webinar on Friday, 26th June, 2020 on 'Covid Patient Counselling'. The key speakers included Dr. K.K. Agarwal, President, Heart Care Foundation of India, Prof. (Dr.) Manju Chhuggani, Dean, School of Sciences and Allied Health, Jamia Hamdard University. Dr. G. K. Arora started the session by welcoming the speakers and participants and introducing the speakers to the audience. Then Dr. Agarwal spoke how the Covid 19 pandemic has led to the fear of the unknown and anxiety about job loss, loss of promotional avenues and uncertain future. He spoke about the long tradition of counselling which has come down to us from the Vedas and other historical epics like Ramayana and Mahabharata. Dr. Manju Chhuggani emphasised the role of counselling for the frontline workers like Nurses who need to be taught and learn the essence of counselling to handle their patients much better in a holistic way. She also emphasised that the Covid patients should try and learn new hobbies and do things of his/her interest. They should connect more with their friends, persons with their same wavelengths whom they can share their thoughts and views. Physical Distancing is more important than Social Distancing. Keeping away from negative thoughts, maintaining personal hygiene and sharing and caring is the right way forward in combating the viral pandemic. The webinar was attended by 270 teachers participants in different fields from across universities in India.

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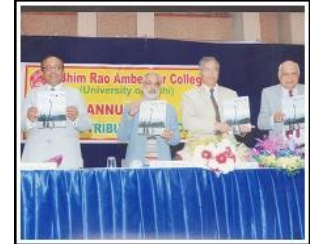
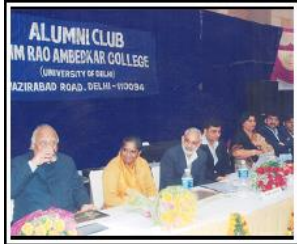

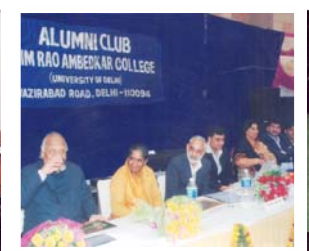
