DR. BHIM RAO AMBEDKAR COLLEGE (BRAC) CAME INTO EXISTENCE ON 8TH FEB 1991 DURING THE BIRTH CENTENARY YEAR OF BHARAT RATNA BABA SAHEB BHIM RAO AMBEDKAR. IT IS A CONSTITUENT CO-EDUCATIONAL COLLEGE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF DELHI AND IS 100 % FUNDED BY DELHI GOVERNMENT. SINCE ITS INCEPTION, IT HAS MAINTAINED ITS INCESSANT MOMENTUM ON THE PATH OF PROGRESS, BOTH IN ACADEMICS AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR FIELDS. THE PRINCIPAL, TEACHING & NON-TEACHING STAFF HAVE DEDICATED THEMSELVES TO BUILD AN ENVIRONMENT OF HOLISTIC AND INCLUSIVE LEARNING, INSPIRING THE YOUTH TO CREATE A FRUITFUL AND RESPONSIBLE FUTURE. THE COLLEGE COMPLETED ITS SILVER JUBILEE (25TH YEAR OF OPERATION) IN 2016 AND THE YEAR WAS CELEBRATED WITH A NUMBER OF ACADEMIC EVENTS, WORKSHOPS AND CONFERENCES. THE COLLEGE IS SITUATED NEAR UPCOMING METRO STATION WHICH WILL SOON BE OPERATIONAL. UNDER THE CAPACITY EXPANSION PLAN INITIATED BY GNCTD, THE UNIVERSITY HAS SELECTED OUR COLLEGE AS ONE OF THE REGIONAL-CUM-STUDY CENTERS TO FACILITATE UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING UNDER PERSONAL CONTACT PROGRAMMED (PCP) FOR SCHOOL OF OPEN LEARNING (SOL) STUDENTS AND NON COLLEGIATE WOMEN'S EDUCATION BOARD (NCWEB) STUDENTS . OUR COLLEGE HAS ALSO BEEN SELECTED AS ONE OF THE 12 CENTERS SPREAD ALL OVER INDIA BY RAJIV GANDHI NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF YOUTH DEVELOPMENT, MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS. THE COLLEGE IS SPREAD OVER 9 ACRES (36,000 M2) OF LUSH GREEN AREA IN THE NORTHEAST DISTRICT OF DELHI ON THE BANKS OF A STREAM FLOWING THROUGH THE REVERED YAMUNA RIVER. THE AIM OF THE COLLEGE IS TO DEVELOP INTO A SELF-SUSTAINED FRIENDLY CAMPUS ENVIRONMENT WITH THE MAXIMUM POSSIBLE FACILITIES. THE COLLEGE IS ONE OF THE 20 CENTERS IN DELHI FOR EARTHQUAKE STRONG GROUND MOTION STATION FOR RECORDING AND MONITORING THE EARTHQUAKES IN DELHI.

THE COLLEGE HAS BEEN SELECTED AS ONE OF THE E-LEARNING CENTERS (OUT OF NINE CHOSEN BY THE UNIVERSITY OF DELHI) UNDER DU-ICICI PARTNERSHIP. IT WILL HELP STUDENTS TO GET THE REQUISITE TRAINING IN THE FIELD OF BANKING AND FINANCE. THE COLLEGE IS THE EAST DELHI CENTRE FOR DU-NIIT JOINT PROGRAMME FOR THE BENEFIT OF UNDERGRADUATE SC/ST STUDENTS . NEARLY 1200 STUDENTS BENEFIT FROM CLASSES HELD ON WEEKENDS AND IN VACATIONS BY THE FACULTY OF THE COLLEGE. THE NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME(NSS) UNIT OF COLLEGE RUNS A VOCATIONAL PROGRAMME FREE OF COST IN COLLABORATION WITH JAN SHIKSHA SANSTHAN, MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT, GOVERNMENT OF INDIA TO IMPART TRAINING TO WOMEN AND CHILDREN OF WEAKER SECTIONS OF THE LOCAL RESIDENTS.

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“STRATEGIES FOR PROMOTING INCLUSIVE DEVELOPMENT”

IN THE AGE OF GLOBALIZING WORLD BACKED UP BY ICTs, STRATEGIES, PRINCIPLES AND BELIEFS HAVE TO BE RESPONSIVE TO THE CHANGES TAKING PLACE TO AFFECT HUMANITY. INCLUSIVE DEVELOPMENT REFERS TO THE GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF A NATION OR STATE WHERE IN EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES EXIST FOR EVERYONE. THIS TERM HAS MANY FACTS INCLUDING SOCIAL, CULTURAL, POLITICAL, ENVIRONMENTAL, ECONOMIC AND INSTITUTIONAL. DEVELOPMENT WILL BE INCLUSIVE IN TRUE SENSE ONLY IF IT FOCUSES ON ALL THE STAKEHOLDERS OF THE SOCIETY WHILE ADDRESSING THE ISSUE OF EXCLUSION OF THE HISTORICALLY AND SYSTEMICALLY DEPRIVED SOCIO-ECONOMICS AND MARGINALIZED GROUPS AND COMMUNITIES INCLUDING TRIBES, WOMEN, SPECIALLY-ABLED, LINGUISTICS AND RELIGIOUS MINORITIES WITH THE PURPOSE OF ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT SOCIAL INCLUSION AND SOCIAL INTEGRATION. CONCEPTUALIZING AND CONTEXTUALIZING INCLUSIVENESS SHOULD THEREFORE BE THE STEPPING STONES TO ANY ENDEAVOR OF VISUALIZING INCLUSIVE DEVELOPMENT. WHILE IT IS TRUE THAT CHRONIC TWIN PROBLEMS OF POVERTY AND EMPLOYMENT MAY NOT BE SOLVED OVERNIGHT, THEIR ALLEVIATION AND MITIGATION CAN BE CONSIDERABLY HASTENED WITH INNOVATIVE, STIMULATING AND PRODUCTIVE TRANSFORMATIONAL STRATEGIES THAT WILL SIGNIFICANTLY UPLIFT THE LIVES OF ALL, INCLUDING THE POOREST OF THE POOR. NEW AMENDMENTS IN FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT HAVE TO BE DESIGNED TO ATTRACT MASSIVE INVESTMENTS WITH A FOCUS ON JOB-CREATION AND POVERTY REDUCTION. THERE IS URGENT NEED OF ENORMOUS INVESTMENT IN INFRASTRUCTURE, FACTORIES, NATURAL RESOURCES, INDUSTRY, AGRICULTURE AND TOURISM. ENVIRONMENT BEING AN IMPORTANT FACTOR AND RECENT CLIMATE CHANGE PHENOMENON BEAR TESTIMONY TO FACT THAT THE DEVELOPMENT HAS TAKEN ITS COST FROM THE ENVIRONMENT BY VARIOUS MEANS OF DEGRADATION. THE NEED OF THE HOUR IS TO INVESTIGATE METHODS AND QUALITY OF GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT WHICH ARE INCLUSIVE, SUSTAINABLE AND ENVIRONMENT FRIENDLY. SINCE, A LARGE CHANGE OF POPULATION IS STILL DEPENDENT ON AGRICULTURAL, STRATEGIES FOR DEVELOPING AGRICULTURAL SECTOR IN A SUSTAINABLE MANNER REPRESENT ONE VIABLE OPTION TO ALLEVIATE THE POVERTY. SUSTAINED ECONOMIC GROWTH, AS THE FOUNDATION FOR REDUCING POVERTY AND CONVERGING HIGH INCOME IS THE RESULT OF INCESSANT STRUCTURAL CHANGE THROUGH INDUSTRIAL UP GRADATION AND DIVERSIFICATION WITH FOCUS ON JOB-CREATION. MEDIA AND LANGUAGE PLAYS AN OUTSTANDING ROLE IN STRENGTHENING THE INCLUSIVE VALUE IN THE SOCIETY BY INFORMING AND EDUCATING.
