We feel motivated to introduce ourselves, i.e. Kalantar Art Foundation as a Section-8 (non-profit) organization working on bringing a huge social revolution by way of practicing various art, and seek your kind support in giving a wide exposure to KALANTAR-2025 (Annual art Festival) being run presently.

The Foundation was established in 2013 and since then, it has been selflessly working to help the society understand and explore the power of art within them. This is being done under the guidance of **our esteemed advisers** PadmShri Prof (Dr) Mahesh Verma, VC, Indraprastha University; Shri Balvinder Kumar (former Secretary Mines and well-known Mental Wellness Coach); Shri Arun Saxena (Adviser to Railway Minister and former GM-NCR) and many others from the corporates.

Sir, in process of the social endeavors, we have been organising Annual Art Festivals, which were started at District level in 2015. Since 2020, the competitions are being organized at National Level on various art forms (on virtual platform). These Art Festivals are not just another competition like many. Every year, we pick one or more theme that resonates with the working of the government and promote them to sensitize the participant about the same. In the past we have taken themes like, Rejuvenation of Rivers (associating with NMCG), Swachhta ka Sankalp (associating with the MoHUA), devotion of our superheroes - the soldiers (associating with the DRDO), bringing out the culture of Uttar Pradesh (associating with the State of Uttar Pradesh). As our achievement to this endeavor, Sri D S Mishra (former Chief Secretary, Uttar Pradesh), Sri Rajiv Ranjan Mishra (former DG-NMCG) and Shri C.N. Sinha, SP, Hathras, Uttar Pradesh have constantly been guiding us till date on our various projects.

With our festivals, we try to connect the most remote and most underprivileged artists in the country. Not just they participate in the competitions, rather, we try to help them regain the art they are missing in their daily hectic schedules and in their monotonous routines. During the past competitions, we were able to connect with many prisons, old age homes, orphanages, etc. We found many senior citizens from the old age homes performing dance, singing and theatre without any expectations of awards or rewards, on the other hand we saw performances from

small children from the orphanages who didn't event knew what Kalantar is all about. We don't hesitate to say that such competitions have also enriched the Foundation by gaining grassroot level experience, motivating us to perform better.

With our art competitions, we also try to find the prospective artists who can be groomed for a better career in the field of art. In one such competition, we found an enthusiastic prisoner, who was trained and was placed as an artist when he got released from the prison. Central Prison of Berhampur, Odisha got the 1st prize in dance competition bringing out their best talents in the front line of the art-related activities. Thus, we can confidently say, that our Art Festivals are not just competitions rather a catalyst to the huge social revolution that we call Mission Kalantar (mission of bringing a difference through art).

Under our flagship program Kala-Deeksha and our wellness program Sukoon, we have trained more than 5000 people from various background (including but not limited to slums, villages, prisons, juvenile prisons, specially abled children and many more). We humbly add that all these trainings are free and materials etc. are provided to students by the Foundation itself, with the support of like minded people, and without any Government funding. Many of our trained students have been able to kick-start their career in the field of art. In a recent achievement, one of our students won 1st prize in the WAVES summit by the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting.

Sir, as per the process of the competition, once the participants sign up through the registration page, they permanently get a dashboard for all information related to the current event and all past events that will follow. The information on the dashboard include:

- · Ongoing competitions they are eligible for:
- Topics of the competition and their related videos;
- · All their competition entries;
- · Online certificates of the entries made by them;
- Announcements of all related events of the festival

Sir, Considering the social impact of this art festival, we request you to share this with institutes under Ministry of Education, encouraging participation of students in various competitions. We are sure that with your kind support, the KALANTAR 2025 – Annual Art Festivals will witness participation from millions of students across various institutes.
