**Notice for choice of Common Courses (SEC, VAC, AEC) for Odd Semester-I**

1. All Semester I students of BA (Hons) and B Com (Hons). Please note that they have to choose their Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and Value Addition Course (VAC) by filling a Google form, the link will open on **30.7.26 at 5 pm** and it is attached in this form also. The last date for submitting the form is **4 August.2026**
2. **Before that they read, understand and go through the syllabus of papers.**

**Please note the following points:**

- The students should carefully fill the google form because this form can be submitted only once. Care should be taken in correctly mentioning the name, college Roll number/ENROLNMENT NO e-mail id and phone number (please provide your own active phone number).
- **Students are not allowed to change their options. They must choose their SEC/VAC course wisely and go thru the syllabus of each course available on DU website also. Students are advised to be careful while filling up the option form because subject once opted cannot be changed. No subject will be allowed to change later on under any circumstances.**
- **All students 'first come first serve' may be adopted as one of the basis for allocation.**
- **Skill Enhancement Course (SEC):**
  - **Objective:** To provide hands-on training, competencies, proficiency, and skills to students.
  - **Content:** Skill-based courses in various disciplines. Some courses are specific to a discipline, while others are open to all students.
  - **Requirement:** Students choose from a pool of skill-based courses provide by different disciplines.

**Guidelines:**

1. A student is required to take any one paper in SEC Category(offered by college department) in each semester.
2. To apply for a particular SEC, the student will be required to fill a google form. The google link will be available on the college website (Students Notice).The students may keep checking the website for the same. The link of college website is as <http://www.drbrambedkarcollege.ac.in/>
3. Please note that, there are limited seats in each SEC. A student, who in case doesn't get the desired SEC paper in semester-I due to limited seats, he/she may opt for same paper in subsequent semesters.
