Please note the following points:

- The students should carefully fill the google form because this form can be submitted only once. Care should be taken in correctly mentioning the name, college roll number, examination roll number, e-mail id and phone number (please provide your own active phone number).

VAC and SEC Information/Guidelines:

- The students **cannot** choose in Semester III exactly the same SEC or VAC, that they have taken in Semesters I or II.
- Some courses are sequel courses like Vedic Mathematics (I, II) and Social Marketing. Only those students who have taken the level I course can take the level II course. Similarly, only those who have taken Digital Marketing can take Social Marketing.

AEC Information/Guidelines:

- All students (Honours and Commerce) who pursued AEC Environmental Science in Semester I will now once again mandatorily pursue EVS in Sem. III.
- The students (Honours and Programme) who pursued an Indian language as AEC in Semester I, will now once again mandatorily pursue the same Indian language AEC. Please note that the language cannot be changed Hindi A, B, C; Sanskrit A, B, C and Urdu A, B, C are available in our college.

All students who want to pursue any AEC language outside the college (for non-availability of such language in the college) should indicate that in the form. They will have to register their names with the cluster colleges through an application and please send a request to Nodal officer (**deepali.jain@bramb.du.ac.in**). In this mail, the students should mention their name, phone number, roll number and the language that they want to pursue outside the college and also fill this **FORM-1(Attached this form)** and verified by the concerned persons.

- All students 'first come first serve' may be adopted as one of the basis for allocation.

Students are not allowed to change their options .They must choose their **SEC/VAC** course wisely and go thru the syllabus of each course available on **DU website also**. Students are advised to be careful while filling up the option form because subject once opted cannot be changed. No subject will be allowed to change later on under any circumstances.
