Dear Shri Taranjit Singh Sandhu Ji,

The idea of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB) which envisages a sustained and structured cultural connect among various States/UTs of India was mooted by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. In order to strengthen people to people connect and build empathy between the youth of our nation, 'Yuva Sangam' programme was launched under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat in early 2023. Yuva Sangam embodies the 'Whole of Government' approach whereby implementation is carried out with the active support and partnership of participating Ministries/Departments and most importantly State governments.

2. Yuva Sangam is an ongoing cultural exchange with celebration of diversity at its core wherein participants gain an immersive experience of diverse facets of life, natural landforms, development landmarks, recent achievement and youth connect in the host state through exposure tours of 5-7 days. Inspired by the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the programme focuses on experiential learning and imbibing first-hand knowledge of the rich diversity of India.

3. During these tours, participants get multi-dimensional exposure under five broad areas-5 Ps i.e. Paryatan (Tourism), Parampara (Traditions), Pragati (Development), Prodyogik (Technology) and Paraspark (People-to-people connect). In addition, meaningful interactions with industrial bodies, associations, State dignitaries local heroes, startup entrepreneurs, artists, singers, sportspersons, musicians, SHGs, NGOs, stalwarts from various spheres etc. are arranged to enrich the overall experience and learnings of the Yuva Sangam delegation.

4. In its last five phases, Yuva Sangam has garnered immense response and participation from all corners of India. More than 6000 participants across India have participated in 134 tours in various phases of the programme (including the pilot phase held under EBSB in 2022) with the spirit of volunteerism and nation building getting infused in the Yuva Sangam delegates.

In light of the heart-warming response to this initiative, this Ministry in coordination with participating Ministries/Departments has launched Yuva Sangam Phase VI involving 22 Higher Education Institutes (HEIs) (list enclosed) which will be serving as nodal institutions for conducting the exposure tours in the State. Online registrations for participation in this Phase had commenced through the Yuva Sangam portal (<https://ebsb.aicte-india.org/>) from 2nd March, 2026 with the cultural-cum-educational-tours are expected to begin from 8th May, 2026.

6. While the state/ district administrations have been requested to extend their support for the tours under Yuva Sangam, it would be highly appreciated if you can take out some time from your busy schedule to inspire and nurture the young minds by holding interactive sessions with them. Your words of wisdom will give them deep insights about diverse facets of the State, instil motivation, foster values and memories to be cherished for a life time.

7. I look forward to your continued cooperation in building Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat as we are in the Amrit kaal & accomplishing the goal of Viksit Bharat, 2047.
